Alpha Omega tasting room coming to downtown Napa

The Alpha Omega Collective, the umbrella brand for Alpha Omega, Tolosa and Perinet wineries, will open a tasting room in the space currently occupied by Capp Heritage at 1245 First St. in downtown Napa this winter.

NapaLife disclosed that the space was for sale Oct. 8.

Terms of the lease agreement were not disclosed. Alpha Omega Collective will feature wines from all three of its brands in the prime corner space directly across the street from the Archer Hotel.

The Alpha Omega Collective includes Alpha Omega on Napa Valley's Rutherford Bench, Tolosa in San Luis Obispo's Edna Valley and Perinet in Spain's Priorat.

The large space includes a spacious tasting room, a lounge that has featured music on Saturdays and some other times and outside seating.

"With all the recent improvements in downtown Napa, the City of Napa has become a hub for wine tourists," said vintner Robin Baggett, who oversees the Alpha Omega Collective with his wife Michelle. "Our three wineries want to be part of this and this puts us right in the middle of all the action."

No decision has apparently been made about continuing or expanding the music or possibly serving food.
