WINEMAKER NOTES

2017 started out with record precipitation providing vines with sufficient water tables to safely get them through several heat spikes that began as early as June. Temperatures up to 110 degrees in early September prompted several winemakers to begin harvesting red varietals. Our winemaking team held steadfast and patiently waited until end of September before bringing in the first red varietals. Rewarded then with more moderate temperatures, the resulting wines express themselves as both full-bodied and greatly structured.

VINEYARD NOTES

ERA is a blend of predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon grapes from awardwinning and historic vineyards throughout the Napa Valley. These vineyards offer distinct qualities and when blended create a beautifully balanced and elegant wine. Each of these vineyards is farmed to yield no more than two tons of fruit per acre with one cluster per shoot resulting in a more intense, flavorful berry. ERA is handcrafted, barrel fermented and is not fined.

ON THE NOSE	Explosion of cassis, peaches, cherries, raspberry jam, violet, lavender, vanilla beans, cotton candy
ON THE PALATE	Soft entrance evolving on a lush but full-bodied midpalate, lingering on dense but granular tannins with a touch of tulip, plum, cassis, elderberry, cherry liquor finishing with iris, pomegranate
BLEND	95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Malbec
FERMENTATION	100% barrel fermented
AGING	22 months in French oak, 80% new, 20% I-year-old barrels
VINEYARDS	Thomas Vineyard (Rutherford), Drew Vineyard (Mount Veeder), Sunshine Valley Vineyard (Oak Knoll District), Beckstoffer To Kalon Vineyard (Oakville), Beckstoffer Las Piedras Vineyard (St. Helena), Sleeping Lady (Yountville)
