



Petit Verdot Napa Valley 2019

WINEMAKER NOTES

2019 provided us with an unprecedented growing season. Moderate to cooler temperatures in early spring resulted in a delayed start followed by showers during bloom in May. However, continual moderate temperatures from June through August allowed vines to balance their growth. By early August, as cluster size was fully developed and overall growth more harmonious, it was clear that 2019 would be a memorable vintage. A month later, most red grapes showed complexities and flavors that normally would not appear until later in season. The 2019 wines show early approachability and impeccable balance.

ABOUT THE VINEYARDS

Alpha Omega Petit Verdot Napa Valley 2019 was handcrafted from fruit grown in premium vineyards located in a variety of sub-appellations, primarily rugged Atlas Peak, Spring Mountain District on the slopes of the Mayacamas Mountains range and Oak Knoll District and Oakville on the valley floor. The multiple sites allow our winemakers to blend a wine that truly expresses the diversity of terroirs in Napa Valley. Petit Verdot thrives in Napa Valley where the consistency of the region's hot climate and poor soils, resulting in smaller berries bursting with intense flavor, is the key to this grape growing so well that our winemakers could not resist producing a nearly 100% Petit Verdot for this vintage.

50% I-year-old barrels; 70% stainless steel tank fermented

AGING 40% new, 40% I-year-old, 20% 2-year-old barrels
